## We can help you if

- You have a disabled child living in your home
- Your child is in hospital and cannot return home until adaptations are made to your current home or a suitable property is found to move into
- You are living in a property that is not suitable for the child's needs
- Your property requires adaptation in order to meet your child's needs



Informing, Enabling, Improving

## DPHS trained staff can help you in the following ways

- Visit you at home or in hospital
- Advice and assistance in completing housing applications
- Provide information on adapted/accessible social housing
- Give advice on Home Ownership Schemes
- Make Occupational Therapy referral for adaptations
- Give funding information to owner occupiers on Local Authority adaptations
- Signpost to other support organisations for the family
- Give information on welfare benefits that may be available to the family
- Offer ongoing Housing support and advocacy on family's behalf as required
